PLAN FEBRUARY 2ND HIKE ASSIGNMENTS

The Deuel Creek hike will be held on February 2nd at 9:00 a.m. beginning at the top of 100 South and 800 East. Denise Cox, Julie Creer, and Mikael Remington will represent the Committee on this hike. Julie Creer will send a notice to all of the elementary schools in Centerville advertising the hike, and a notice will be given to The Davis Clipper for publication.

UPDATE ON GRANT PROCESS

Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, reported he submitted a grant today for federal funds to help meet the goals of the Wasatch Front Regional Council for alternative transportation and for the Wasatch Choice 2040 Vision. The grant money being requested is for \$856,750, which would be used to widen the Frontage Road from eight to ten feet, and then a bike lane would be striped on each side of the road. Even if the money is awarded, it would be a few years before the work would actually begin. Chair Denise Cox thanked Mr. Cox for his work in researching and submitting this grant.

POTENTIAL VOLUNTEER PROJECT DISCUSSION

The Trails Committee compiled the following list of service ideas for volunteer groups and Eagle Scout projects that could begin in the spring.

- Water diversion project on the Freedom Hills Trail.
- Ford Canyon maintenance.

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- Place crushed volcanic salt along the Freedom Hills Trails, as the snakes do not like to crawl on the salt because it irritates their bellies, and it will keep them off the trail.
- Dead fall maintenance on all of the trails.
- Replanting of the vegetation and erosion control on George Haddad's property.
- Placement of signs on various trails.

ELECT/RE-ELECT COMMITTEE CHAIR FOR 2013

Chair Denise Cox made a **motion** to nominate Matt Johnson as chair of the Trails Committee for the year 2013. Rick Turner seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (5-0).

The next Trails Committee meeting will be held on Thursday, February 21, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the Public Works Building. Chair Denise Cox asked Committee members to be prepared to discuss ideas on extending the trail above the Freedom Hills Park to the Pretty Valley area in Bountiful.
