MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

Minutes of the January 16, 2014 meeting minutes were reviewed. Chair Matt Johnson made a **motion** to approve the minutes as written. Denise Cox seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (4-0).

PARRISH ZIG ZAG TRAIL NAME

Royce Allen said the trails map that was in the recent City Newsletter, lists the Parrish Switchback or Zig Zag Trail as the Parrish Trail. Mr. Allen called Earl Tingey to see what the correct name of the trail is, and Mr. Tingey said the name is the Zig Zag Trail. Mr. Allen asked that the Parrish Trail name be changed on the trail markers and on other maps that are printed to the Zig Zag Trail. Also, one of the peaks that is east of Hogsback Point does not have a name, and he asked what the name of the peak is. The Trails Committee is not aware of the name of this peak. He suggested when the map is printed again, that the name of the peak be listed. Mr. Allen talked about other trails and points of interests in the Centerville mountains.

At 8:05 p.m., Alan Peterson was excused from the meeting.

a. **Bike Facilities Engineering Meeting**

Chair Johnson reported the Bike Facilities Engineering Meeting was moved to Orem, so he was not able to attend. He was given the manual for the bike standards.

b. **Pedestrian Overpass**

Stephanie Ivie, City Council Liaison, reported the pedestrian overpass will be constructed on the north side of Parrish Lane. It will be a ten-foot wide cement bridge that will not be covered. It is planned to be completed in early 2015.

c. **Legacy Trail Head**

Mark Dimond reported he talked with Steve Thacker, City Manager, regarding a small piece of property that will be extended to connect to the Legacy Trail just north of the West Bountiful property line. This will be an access to the Legacy Trail in Centerville.

"RACE THE MAYOR" 5K and 10K TRAIL RUN, PLANS

Stephanie Ivie, City Council Liaison, reported Mayor Cutler's niece is getting married on April 26th, the day of the scheduled race, and will be unable to attend. Mikael Remington will be asked to print posters advertising the run, and Denise Cox will have the race advertised in The Clipper.

The Trails Committee suggested a field trip to view projects that could be added to the master list. Rick Turner will be asked to contact the ATV Club to ask for money to help with the rehabilitation projects on the mountain where the ATV's have eroded.
