MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

Minutes of the May 15, 2014 Trails Committee meeting minutes were reviewed. Denise Cox made a **motion** to approve the minutes as amended. Matt Johnson seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (5-0).

FOLLOW UP TO VOLUNTEER PROJECTS MASTER LIST

Denise Cox reported she has started the Volunteer Projects Master List, but it is not completed at this time. Rick Turner reported there are at least ten volunteer projects that could be completed in the mountains. Tyler West will talk to Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, and ask him to inform the Trails Committee when he becomes aware of any Eagle Scout projects that could be completed on the trails and in the mountains. A list of suggested Eagle Scout projects will be displayed at the 4th of July booth.

HILLSIDE SIGNS REPORT

The Police Department has approved of posting signs in the bowl area and on the Bonneville Shoreline Trail/Fire break road informing people to ride their ATV's on marked trails. The signs also state there will be up to a \$1,000 fine for the discharge of firearms in this area. A picture of the sign was displayed. Rick Turner will talk with George Haddad to see if he would allow these signs to be posted on his property. Thomas Tasker will talk with Police Chief Neal Worsley to see what the ordinances are for the discharging of firearms on private property, and what the fine is if violators are caught.

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FOLLOW UP TO JULY 1ST BIKE EVENT

The Bike Ride Event will be held on Tuesday, July 1st at 7:00 p.m. on the Firebreak Road. Participants are to meet at top of Firebreak Road. There will be a 5k and 10k distance, the same routes that were used for the Race for the Mayor last May. Mark Dimond will be asked to mark the trails prior to this event.

At 7:50 p.m., Rick Turner was excused from the meeting.

The Parks and Recreation Department will be asked to provide water for this event. Mikael Remington will have his scout group help with directions, and passing out water. The Police Department will be asked to do a short bike safety demonstration prior to the ride. This event will be advertised on the City website, Bountiful Bicycle, Top Gear Cycling, and at the Scout Round Table meeting.

4TH OF JULY BOOTH

Denise Cox talked with Dale Anderson, and a booth will be available for the Trails Committee for the 4th of July. Posters and books from Royce Allen will be displayed, along with the Eagle Scout projects that are available to be completed. Trail Committee activities will be advertised, and the new Davis County Trail Map will be available for purchase. Denise Cox will be at the booth the evening of July 3rd. Alan Peterson, Matt Johnson, and Mikael Remington will work at the booth on July 4th. Thomas Tasker and Mikael Remington will set-up the booth on July 3rd.

MISCELLANEOUS

Stephanie Ivie, City Council Liaison, reported Ross Smedley approached her and asked her if anything in the City needs to be named. Mr. Smedley is a descendant of William Streeper who was the first Justice of the Peace, and the last Pony Express Rider in Centerville. The Committee discussed possible trails that do not have a name that could be named after William Streeper.
