Chair Alan Peterson welcomed Jeremiah Moore as the Youth City Council Liaison to the Trails Committee. Jeremiah is a senior at Viewmont High School.

MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

Minutes of the September 18, 2014 meeting minutes were reviewed. Mikael Remington made a **motion** to approve the minutes as written. Mark Dimond seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (5-0).

FOLLOW UP TO VOLUNTEER PROJECTS MASTER LIST

Denise Cox reported she started a new volunteer projects master list, since the previous list was lost. Matt Johnson is working with a Boy Scout who will be placing and cementing sign posts for signs on the Fire Break Road. The Eagle Scout will also remove graffiti off the rocks near the Ricks Creek Waterfall. Railroad ties at the beginning of the Rockwood Trail need to be filled in with soil, and a diverter for runoff water, to prevent erosion, needs to be installed. Water bars on Parrish Trail need to be dug out, or replaced. Mikael Remington reported he ran on a trail in Ogden last week, and he noticed that large pieces of rubber tires have been used along the trail in other cities to help prevent erosion. He suggested rubber tire pieces could be used on the Centerville trails to help prevent erosion. Thomas Tasker reported there are three Eagle Scout projects that could be completed on the Parrish Trail.

FOLLOW UP TO UPDATE OF TRAILS MAP

Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, worked with Mike Smith on updating the trails map on the City website. Mr. Smith has updated the D&RG Trail, and also the Ford Canyon Trail to Main Street on the trails map.

PRELIMINARY DRAFT

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Bruce Cox reported a new Frisbee golf course at the Freedom Hills Park has been laid out.

FOLLOW UP TO MEETING WITH MAYOR ON HILLSIDE ISSUES

Members of the Trails Committee recently met with Mayor Cutler to discuss with George Haddad, hillside issues. It was agreed to plan some service projects, and then meet with the Mayor again to discuss what further action should be taken.

a. Hillside Projects

Mikael Remington reported he and Rick Turner trimmed shrubs along the Ford Canyon Trail to the waterfall on George Haddad's property. They moved logs and rocks on the trail to discourage ATV riders from riding on private property. Three signs have been placed at this site to inform people to stay on the Fire Break Road.

The Committee agreed the first project will be to drive in posts for Fire Break Road Signs in critical damage areas. This project will be completed on October 14th. Committee members are to meet at the Parrish Trail Head at 5:30 p.m.

DISCUSSION AND ASSIGNMENTS FOR CITY COUNCIL HILLSIDE AGENDA ITEM

The Committee was going to meet with the City Council on October 21st, but they feel they need more time to prepare. It was agreed to meet with the City Council on November 4th regarding hillside issues. The Trails Committee will meet at 6:00 p.m. on this date to finalize plans for the Council presentation. Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, will provide pictures of the signage that has been put up for the City Council presentation. Chair Peterson will contact Police Chief Worsley and ask him to discuss the problems and issues the police have encountered on the hillside. The meeting with the City Council is to inform them of the plans the Trails Committee has for reducing hillside abuse.
