MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

Minutes of the April 16, 2015 Trails Committee meeting were reviewed. Chair Alan Peterson made a **motion** to approve the minutes as written. Mark Dimond seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (3-0).

CENTENNIAL HIKE AND MILE LOG UPDATE

The Committee reported on the Trail Fun Run that was held on May 16th at the Parrish Lane Trail Head. There were 16 people who ran the race, and the low attendance was probably due to the State High School Track Meet that was held the same day. It was suggested next year eliminating the quarterly hikes and teaming with the Bonneville Shoreline Trail Race that is held each year on the Shoreline Trail. Denise Cox will contact Wasatch Running to verify the exact date of the Bonneville Shoreline Trail Race.

The Centennial Hike will be held on Monday, June 15th at 6:30 p.m. with Royce Allen at the Parrish Lane Trail Head. The Parks and Recreation Department will provide water for the hike. There will be no Centennial pins given away at this activity. It has been decided there will be a Centennial Raffle held in August, and raffle tickets will be given away at this activity for the raffle.

DISCUSS REVISIONS TO THE TRAILS PORTION OF THE GENERAL PLAN IN SECTION 12-450-3, INCLUDING REVIEWING THE BICYCLE MASTER PLAN DRAFT

Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, explained when the General Plan was written, it was intended there would not be bike lanes on the roads. It was planned to have separate paved bike paths adjacent to the roads. This has changed, and bike lanes are now painted on the roads. Mr. Cox distributed a map of the Centerville Parks and Trails & Proposed Bike Lanes for Centerville. Eventually, major roads in Centerville will have bike lanes. The Frontage Road will be widened 10 feet by 2018, and bike lanes will be striped on this road.

REVIEW HILLSIDE MAP OF TRAILS AND PROPERTY LINES

The Committee discussed publishing a notice and a map in the next City Newsletter of the private property areas on the hillside where people should not trespass.

OTHER BUSINESS

This will be the last meeting for Jordan Hawkes, as he is leaving to serve an LDS Mission to Taiwan.

Chair Peterson made a **motion** to recognize Jordan Hawkes for his efforts in serving with the Trails Committee. Denise Cox seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (3-0).
