CANVASS OF 2021 GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS

Councilmember Ivie made a **motion** that the City Council sit as the Board of Canvassers to canvass the returns of the 2021 General Election. Councilmember Ince seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote (5-0). City Recorder Jennifer Hansen reported 5,205 ballots were cast in the General Election (50.72% voter turnout).

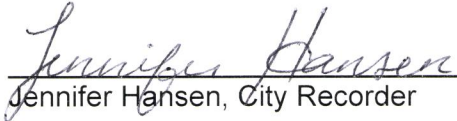

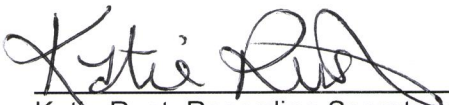
