SUBJECT:

According to State law as provided in UCA 20A-4-301(2)(b)(ii), the Mayor and City Council, acting as the board of municipal canvassers, shall meet to canvass the returns from a municipal general election no sooner than seven (7) days and no later than fourteen (14) after the election.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Council, acting as the Board of Canvassers, should canvass the returns of the November 2, 2021 General Election, according to State law as set forth in UCA 20A-4-301(2)(b)(ii).

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Utah law, the Mayor and City Council constitute the board of municipal canvassers for the City. The board of canvassers is required to meet to canvass the returns at the usual place of meeting and shall canvass the returns from the municipal general election no sooner than 7 days and no later than 14 days after the general election. The board of canvassers shall canvas the election returns by publicly opening the returns and determining from them the votes of each voting precinct for each person voted for. The board of canvassers shall declare "elected" or "nominated" those persons who had the highest number of votes and shall certify the vote totals for persons that were submitted to voters within the board's jurisdiction and transmit those vote totals to the lieutenant governor. The Davis County Elections Office will provide the final vote tabulation, including provisional and mail-in/absentee ballots, for the board of canvassers to be considered at the meeting. We will probably receive the final results on the 16th.
