23 Mayor Pro Tem Hirst called the work session to order at 6:05 p.m.

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25 **PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR REPORT**

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27 Public Works Director Mike Carlson provided an update on the City's water system,
28 drainage system, and street projects. He reported current City water well levels, spoke of difficulty
29 hiring two additional full-time employees, and explained supply chain difficulties. Mr. Carlson
30 reported on a grant for construction of a water tank, and spoke of the possibility of connecting
31 approximately 250 residences currently without an irrigation water connection to the irrigation
32 water system.

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34 Councilmember Summerhays said he would like button-activated flashing crosswalk signs
35 included in the next budget for key intersections in the City. Mr. Carlson said he could gather cost
36 estimates. Councilmember Hirst suggested involving the Police Department. Councilmember Ince
37 said he believed the issue was more of a pedestrian issue than a vehicle issue. Councilmember
38 Hirst suggested public education would be important.

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40 Mr. Carlson reported on winter season snow and leaf removal plans, and answered
41 questions from the Council. Mr. Carlson said he really enjoyed his job and appreciated the
42 individuals with whom he worked. The City Council thanked Mr. Carlson for the report.
