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20 **MINUTES REVIEW AND UPDATE**

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22 Minutes of the May 19, 2022 meeting were reviewed. Del Ruesch made a **motion** to
23 approve the minutes as written. Mitzi Gray seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous
24 vote (5-0).

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26 **NEW FACEBOOK PAGE**

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28 Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, reported that Bryce King, Community
29 Services Manager, has made a new Centerville City Facebook page. Anything that is scheduled or
30 planned as a Trails Committee would be posted on the city webpage. Mitzi Gray will update the
31 city webpage on Trail Committee activities.

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33 **GUN RANGE SIGNAGE/TRAIL**

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35 Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, reported he and Matt Johnson, Mikael
36 Remington, Brent Hanson, and Lisa Romney met with the Gun Range Board members to discuss
37 the concerns of hiking near the gun range. The hiking trail is 600 yards from the gun range. The
38 Gun Club destroyed the top and bottom of the trail, so that hikers would not be able to access the
39 trail. This was done without contacting the city or the Trails Committee. The Trails Committee
40 will order five new signs that will be posted at the entrance of the trails to warn hikers of the Gun
41 Range.

NORTH DEUEL CREEK TRAIL MAINTENANCE

Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, reported the Davis County Outdoor Recreation Director, Jeff Oiler has approved the designated trailhead and area on the North Deuel Creek Trailhead, but the Irrigation Company is not cooperating. Mr. Summerhays said he will ask City Council member, Gina Hirst, to get involved with the Irrigation Company on this matter.

Del Ruesch reported the water bars that were installed several years ago are channeling the water into the side of the hill, which is eroding the trail. The bars need to be replaced.

Trail maintenance will be done on North Deuel Creek Trail on October 29th, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

NEW TRAIL TO "V" UPDATE

The Viewmont Cross Country Team did a service project last week, by improving the trail to the "V" on the mountain. Six new switch backs have been made on the trail, which is one-tenth of a mile.

PLANS/ACTIVITIES FOR 2023

The Trails Committee discussed activities for 2023. They are:

- Connect existing trails, and have better flow on the trails.
- Do organized trail runs and mountain bike rides on the trails.
- Bonneville Shoreline Trail Ride. (Organized by Bountiful City).

BST RIDE WITH BOUNTIFUL/CENTERVILLE COUNCIL MEMBERS UPDATE

Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, reported Bountiful City is making trails that will connect to the Bonneville Shoreline Trail in Centerville. The future plan is to connect the trail from Ogden to Salt Lake City.

DAVID NASH PROPERTY UPDATE

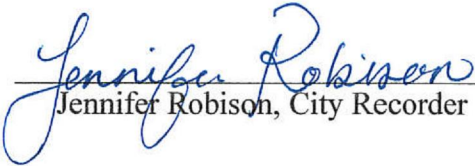

NEXT MEETING

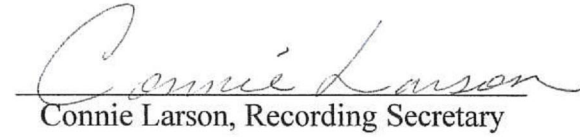
The next Parks and Recreation Committee meeting will be held on Thursday, January 19, 2023 at 8:00 p.m. at City Hall.
