TRAIL MAINTENANCE DAY – UPDATE

Trail Maintenance Day was held on June 3rd. Mikael Remington reported there were two projects running concurrently, and there were around 40 people in attendance. Most of the volunteers were students who are on local mountain bike teams. Brandon Frederico reported he rode the ORM trails west of the Firebreak Road, and the corners are much better and easier to turn on since the maintenance was completed.

Sherrae Phelps reported the Parrish Creek and the North Deuel Creek Trails need to have more work done, but they are close to being finished. There is a section of trail on the North Deuel Creek Trail that is on Deuel Creek Irrigation Company property. The City Council has reached out to the company for permission to work on the property, but they will not allow it.

Mikael Remington met with Jim Stewart on the Freedom Hills Trails, and Mr. Remington showed Mr. Stewart what needs to be done with the water bars. Someone dug out the back of the water bars three inches deep, which can be dangerous for people riding mountain bikes. Mr. Stewart said he will fill in the areas with dirt, so that they are smooth. Mr. Stewart will contact Mikael Remington or Del Ruesch when he is ready to work on this project.

The Trail Parks App is a trails app that lists the trails in the area to ride and hike. The Trails Committee viewed a map of the mountain trails above Centerville. More Community Trail Service Days will be held in the future. The Just Serve Website was more successful at recruiting volunteers than the Centerville City Facebook page.

MASTER PLAN PREPARATION – WISH LIST OF FUTURE TRAILS

Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, reported the Planning Commission is not ready at this time for a work session on future trails and Master Plan preparation.

The Trails Committee identified items for their wish list. They are:

- Add a parameter trail on the south side of the Community Park.
- Improve the Sunset Trail.
- Achieve more access for the trails. The Master Plan says anytime there is a change or sale of property, it can be reviewed to see if there is a possibility of making more trails or connecting trails.
- Section of the Deuel South Creek Trail is eroded and needs a “bench cut.”

Mr. Cox explained the current Master Plan needs to be reviewed to see what it says about trails. At the next Trails Committee meeting, the City Ordinance on the Trails Committee will be reviewed. Mikael Remington will email Cory Snyder, Community Development Director, on the next steps that can be completed while waiting for the General Plan to be reviewed by the Planning Commission.
