20 Jake Santini was introduced as a new member of the Trails Committee. Mr. Santini is a
21 friend of Mikael Remington, and he enjoys biking and running.

23 **HIKING STICKER – PARRISH TRAIL**

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25 The Trails Committee was not sure what this item is about, but they believe Sherrae Phelps
26 was working on this item as part of a fundraising program to help with improvements on the Parrish
27 Trail. Projects are a bike kiosk on the trail to repair bike tires, and for possibly a restroom at the
28 trailhead where the parking area is. The Committee discussed fundraising for a restroom, and there
29 is a good possibility that companies and individuals would donate for this project. Bruce Cox,
30 Parks and Recreation Director, will be contacted for his input on a restroom for the Parrish Trail.
31 Brandon Frederico will contact CIS Engineering to see what it would cost to get water, sewer, and
32 electricity if a restroom can be built.

34 **PROJECTS TO COMPLETE BEFORE END OF YEAR**

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36 The Freedom Hills Trail needs to have the water bars set to prevent erosion on the trail.
37 Del Ruesch said his church group was going to do this project for the September 11th service day,
38 but the group decided to do a different project. The Committee discussed this project and agreed
39 they would like to do it on October 7th. Brandon Frederico will send an email to Committee
40 members to inform them of this project, and the other projects that need to be completed.

42 Additional trail work needs to be completed on the Zig-Zag Trail, but this has been put on
43 hold until Bountiful City can be contacted. The work on the Zig-Zag Trail is to widen the trail with
44 a bench cut, and have it end where the windsock is at the Bountiful Gun Range. The Committee
45 discussed a possible fundraiser for this project, as heavy equipment would need to be used.

The Deuel Creek North Trail needs to be finished. Del Ruesch said most of the volunteer workers went to the South Trail on the Day of Service. The North Trail needs more switch back trails and water bars. These two trails and the Freedom Hills Park Trail must be completed before winter.

MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

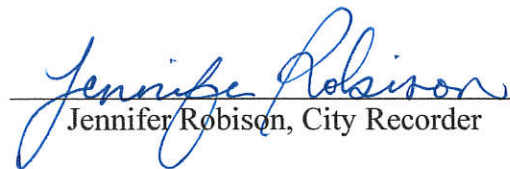

NEXT MEETING

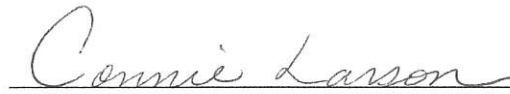
