DISCUSSION – ASSISTANT POLICE CHIEF

Police Chief Paul Child explained that the job descriptions of the Lieutenant and Assistant Police Chief positions had involved the same duties and pay in the Centerville Police Department for several years, although the Assistant Police Chief position tended to garner more prestige when associating with other departments and agencies. Chief Child expressed a desire to explore making a distinct difference between the Lieutenant and Assistant Police Chief positions, with an individual needing to serve for some amount of time as Lieutenant before being eligible for promotion to Assistant Police Chief. The Chief explained his desire to have a succession plan in place within the Department, and answered questions from the Council. Councilmember Ince said he believed the proposed change made sense. Councilmembers Hirst and Summerhays said they agreed.

At 6:47 p.m., Councilmember Ince **moved** to adjourn the work session. Councilmember Summerhays seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote (4-0).
