### **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

### **2024 TRAILS COMMITTEE BUDGET**

Mikael Remington reported he has submitted a list of itemized items for the Trails Committee for the 2024 budget. The budget items are as follows:

- One dozen 2 x 12 feet pressure treated rebar for trail erosion projects.
- One dozen 2 x 6 feet pressure treated rebar for trail erosion projects.
- Geotech style mat to prevent erosion.
- Wood trail markers to replace fiberglass markers.
- McLeod tool and other tools for trail maintenance.
- Food for participants at the 10k/5k race, and for volunteers on trail maintenance projects.
- Food for the Grand Opening of the Sunset Trail.

### **SURVEY**

The Trails Committee reviewed the proposed Trails Survey that will be posted on April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024 for the citizens to complete. The survey will be available for two weeks before it is taken down.
