MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

Minutes of the December 13, 2023 work session were reviewed. Mikael Remington made a **motion** to approve the minutes as written. Mitzi Gray seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (5-0).

2024 TRAILS COMMITTEE BUDGET

Mikael Remington reported he has submitted a list of itemized items for the Trails Committee for the 2024 budget. The budget items are as follows:

- One dozen 2 x 12 feet pressure treated rebar for trail erosion projects.
- One dozen 2 x 6 feet pressure treated rebar for trail erosion projects.
- Geotech style mat to prevent erosion.
- Wood trail markers to replace fiberglass markers.
- McLeod tool and other tools for trail maintenance.
- Food for participants at the 10k/5k race, and for volunteers on trail maintenance projects.
- Food for the Grand Opening of the Sunset Trail.

SURVEY

The Trails Committee reviewed the proposed Trails Survey that will be posted on April 8th, 2024 for the citizens to complete. The survey will be available for two weeks before it is taken down.

At 8:40 p.m., Sherrae Phelps arrived at the meeting.

The Trails Survey will be posted on the Trails Committee Facebook page for two weeks. Trail signs with the QR code will be posted at the Community Park, Salt Lake Running Store, REI, and Guthrie's Bicycle Store. The purpose of the survey is to obtain feedback from the citizens to help establish the Trails Master Plan.

At 8:55 p.m., Council Member Spencer Summerhays was excused from the meeting.

TRAILS MASTER PLAN

Mitzi Gray suggested more public input be obtained through an open house and workshop for the Trails Master Plan.

TRAIL MAINTENANCE

The Trails Committee was asked to bring a list of ideas to the March meeting for trails maintenance projects that need to be completed.

MISCELLANEOUS

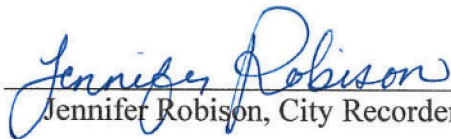

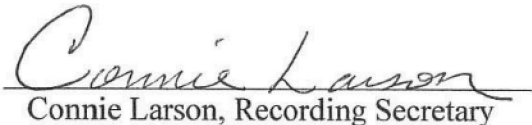
NEXT MEETING
