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23 **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

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25 Minutes of the February 15, 2024 meeting were reviewed. Mitzi Gray made a **motion** to  
26 approve the minutes as written. Del Ruesch seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous  
27 vote (4-0).

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29 **2024 BUDGET**

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31 Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, reported the 2024 Trails Committee budget  
32 for \$3,700 was submitted, and the City Council did not make any changes to it. The tentative  
33 budget will be released in May.

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35 **SURVEY**

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37 Mikael Remington reported he told Bryce King to continue to allow the Trail Surveys to  
38 be received until there are no surveys coming in.

**TRAILS MASTER PLAN**

The Trails Master Plan will not begin until the surveys are reviewed. Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, reported the new Community Development Director said the Trails Master Plan should be ready to begin in May. It will take 12 to 18 months to incorporate it into the city Master Plan.

Mikael Remington reported he met with Kate Bradshaw from the Bountiful City Trails Committee. There is a gap between the Centerville and Bountiful trails at the "V," and she would like to try and make the trail connection at this location gentler and not go through the Gun Range. Perhaps something could be done below the "V" to make it easier for people to access. Ms. Bradshaw would like to do a lunch field trip with the Centerville and Bountiful Trails Committees to view this area and see what can be done to improve the trails. Mr. Remington will contact Ms. Bradshaw to schedule a date for the meeting.

**TRAIL MAINTENANCE**

Mikael Remington reported he will be conducting a hike on April 27<sup>th</sup> to view the petroglyphics, and do trail maintenance on the trail below the "V." The Trails Committee discussed the damage that Sur Ron bikes are causing on the mountain trails, and the danger they pose for hikers and mountain bikers.

Trail Committee members will install "No Motorized Vehicles" signs on the trails. The Police Chief and Rotary Club members have already installed flags on the trails.

**GOALS/PROJECTS**

The Trails Committee discussed trails that have areas of corrosion that need to be repaired, and areas that have been washed out during the winter months. Mikael Remington will create a spreadsheet of trails and other areas that need repairs. Some of the areas discussed are:

- Lower "V" trail.
- BST Bridge at Deuel Creek.
- Upper "Don't Shoot Me Up" Trail.
- Freedom Hills Trail.
- Parrish Trail – needs to be redone. Forest Service will need to be involved with this trail.

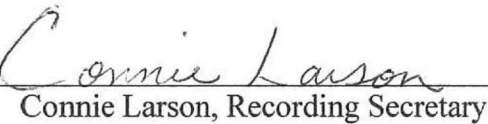
