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16 **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

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18 Minutes of the July 18, 2024 meeting were reviewed. Mikael Remington made a **motion**
19 to approve the minutes as written. Sherrae Phelps seconded the motion, which was passed by
20 unanimous vote (6-0).

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22 **MAP MARKING SESSION WITH TRAIL SURVEY RESULTS**

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24 The Trails Committee was planning to take the results from the Trails Survey and map the
25 top interests that were received from the survey. Brandon Frederico suggested mapping the results
26 in Google or print the map. Mikael Remington will ask Mike Smith to print an 11 x 16 map for
27 each Committee member. The results of the survey will be emailed to each Committee member,
28 and they will mark their map with the results from the survey. The Legacy Trail is County property,
29 and Centerville is not responsible for it.

31 **IMBA DISCUSSION**

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33 Brandon Frederico reported he received the Intermountain Biking Association (IMBA)
34 map information from Todd Christensen and Melanie Larsen. He would like to get a map that has
35 the suggested route to walk the section between the Bountiful Gun Range to the Deuel Creek
36 Trailhead. The Trails Committee discussed working with Bountiful on the connector trail to make
37 it go down and away from the Gun Range.

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39 **UTILITY COMPANY EASEMENTS**

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41 Brandon Frederico reported he and his wife have been hiking in the mountains, and on the
42 Firebreak Road near the Zamoti property there is a trailer and RV parked on the road, which is
43 illegal. It is not known if the vehicles are owned by Aren Zamoti, and there have also been signs
44 posted near the Zamoti property for people to stay off the property. It is not known if Mr. Zamoti
45 has confronted anyone on the property. Property taxes on the Zamoti property have not been paid
46 for nearly four years.

1 Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, said he will contact Tage Flint at the Weber Water
2 Basin District, to see what she says about bonding issues, and he will also contact the easement
3 owners.

5 **DAY OF SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES**

7 Mikael Remington reported there have been improvements made on the north Deuel Creek
8 Trail, but more improvements need to be done. Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison,
9 reported there have been five rescue operations so far this year near the small waterfall on that
10 trail. It is slippery and people fall easily. He suggested asking the Fire Department how to improve
11 this trail to make it safer.

13 Sherrae Phelps said the Bernard Trail needs foliage cut back and cleared. There is a scout
14 troop that installed a new bridge on this trail four days ago. The Deuel Creek Trail needs a kiosk
15 or trail marker with a tribute to the Nash family who helped with the construction of this trail.
16 There is a hole below the Jurassic Bridge that needs to be filled. Mikael Remington will contact
17 the Trails Committee if there is more interest to help with the trails on September 7th.

19 **MISCELLANEOUS**
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21 Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, reported he heard from Nichole Miller on the
22 sale of a piece of property by Sheep Rock.

23
24 Brandon Frederico said the road by the Fire Break Road near Sandhill has been cut into,
25 and large boulders have been brought in. It is not known what is being constructed, as this is
26 County property.

27
28 Mitzi Gray reported she researched the Rockwood property, and the Rockwood's used to
29 own the property where the trails are for many decades. She heard that Mr. Rockwood is talking
30 about fencing an area above the trails and placing horses there. This would be County property,
31 and it is not known if they would allow this. Also, it would involve the Fire Break Road, and this
32 road cannot be blocked.

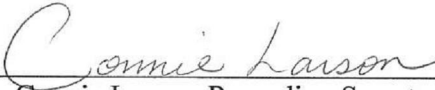
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39 **ADJOURN**
