19 **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

21 Minutes of the April 9, 2024 meeting were reviewed. Adam Alba made a **motion** to
22 approve the minutes as written. Sean Hall seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous
23 vote (4-0).

25 **COMMUNITY PARK PLAYGROUND**

27 Haley Turner, Community Services Manager, displayed brochures of playground
28 equipment from various outdoor recreation companies. She asked the Parks and Recreation
29 Committee to review the brochures and obtain bids from the companies they feel whose
30 playground equipment would work best at the Community Park playground. The City Council
31 would like to have playground equipment that is different and unique, and will draw people to the
32 park.

34 **At 7:37 p.m., Haley Turner was excused from the meeting.**

36 Adam Alba explained the city received a \$300,000 grant approval for playground
37 equipment at the Community Park on the east side of the park. Landscaping for the area
38 surrounding the playground will also be landscaped in the amount of \$50,000, which will be taken
39 from the grant. The Committee discussed the features of the Castle Park in Fruit Heights and the
40 Ninja Park in St. George. The Ninja Park has an obstacle course and a zipline that are popular
41 attractions at this park. The Garret proposal was discussed, but the shade feature would put the
42 cost at \$392,000.

The Committee agreed the following amenities will be at the park:

- Climbing spiral structure
- Swings
- Zipline
- Running course
- Tower feature

Matt Layton will research the cost of a sprint track feature.

PARKS MASTER PLAN

Adam Alba reported the last time the Parks and Recreation Master Plan was updated was in 2012 when an intern completed it for his thesis. The City Council has asked the Committee to be more involved and give their ideas on how to upgrade the parks. Aaron Getz suggested a survey where citizens can give their responses on how the parks can be improved. The demographics of Centerville is changing to where there is now more of an aging population and fewer families with children.

Sean Hall discussed ways to improve Movies in The Park. He would like to see food trucks and perhaps a concert before the movie. He said Bountiful has Food Truck Friday with vendors at the water park every Friday evening, which has been very successful.

PICKLEBALL COURTS PROGRESS

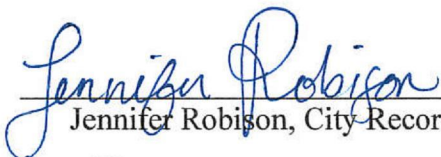
Bruce Cox has the report on the pickleball courts progress, but he did not attend the meeting.

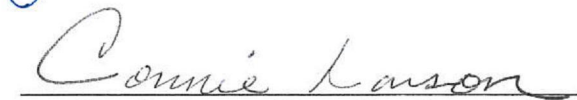
NEXT MEETING
