BRANDING DISCUSSION

Sydney Bishop with Jibe Media presented a preliminary style guide that emphasized a "formal but friendly" tone and the tagline "Meet Us In The Middle." Ms. Bishop outlined the brand foundation, visual identity elements, and applications, receiving praise from council members for capturing Centerville's community feel and small-town atmosphere. Bryce King outlined the implementation timeline, with internal branding planned for 2024-2025 and external branding for 2025-2026, ensuring consistency across city communications.

DISCUSSION - CEMETERY UPDATE

Mayor Clark Wilkinson introduced the discussion on a new cemetery location, highlighting it as a long-standing issue. City Engineer Kevin Campbell presented a potential site on city-owned foothill land but noted challenges such as steep slopes, accessibility, and nearby noise. Councilmembers raised concerns about dust, noise, vandalism, hillside stability, and the site's impact on nearby homes, debating its suitability for a cemetery versus recreational use. The council decided to investigate further, with Mr. Campbell proposing a geological study and Councilmember Spencer Summerhays suggesting exploring a land swap with the Forest Service, aiming to reconvene at a later date with more information.

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At 6:46 pm, Councilmember Summerhays **moved** to adjourn the work session, which passed by unanimous vote (5-0).
