MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

Minutes of the December 4, 2024 meeting were reviewed. Brandon Frederico made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Jake Santini seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (4-0).

DISCUSS TRAILS MASTER PLAN

Brandon Frederico reported the Trails Master Plan is not integrated at this time. Mitzi White said she is integrating the map, and she will cut it into smaller maps, as it is very large. Brandon Frederico will ask Trent Smith to look at the maps, and then they will be sent to Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, for his approval. The maps will then be given to the City Council for their approval. The map could be made into smaller maps, and then have a link into each map.

The Trails Committee viewed slides of shade structures, picnic tables, and restroom facilities to get ideas for the trails. Mitzi White will send pictures of inspirational quotes for the trailhead signs to Brandon Frederico, and then they will be given to Trent Smith. Mitzi pointed to the map and showed where there are trails missing from the map. The debris bridge at Bernard Creek is not shown on the map, and the bridge and trail to the petroglyphs is not shown on the map. A section of the Firebreak Road is also not shown. Mike Smith will be asked to make edits on the map, and it will be dropped into the slides and changed to be more aesthetically pleasing. Trent Smith will be asked to make these changes on the map.

Brandon Frederico said he will take the trails map as it is, and send it to Spencer Summerhays, City Council Liaison, tonight. Mr. Summerhays will be asked to give any suggestions back to Brandon as soon as possible. Brandon Frederico will also work with Trent Smith, and the final map will be sent to the City Council when Spencer Summerhays has reviewed it. Hopefully, the map will be sent to the City Council by December 24, 2024.

MISCELLANEOUS

Allen Phelps reported his daughter is heading a club for Environmental Preservation. REI is going to be involved with this club, and they want a date for when the first meeting will be held. The Trails Committee would also like to be involved with the club, and to possibly have an open house that will inform the public of what is happening with trails conservation in Centerville.
