**COMMUNITY PARK PLAYGROUND**

Haley Turner, Community Services Manager, displayed brochures of playground equipment from various outdoor recreation companies. She asked the Parks and Recreation Committee to review the brochures and obtain bids from the companies they feel whose playground equipment would work best at the Community Park playground. The City Council would like to have playground equipment that is different and unique, and will draw people to the park.

Adam Alba explained the city received a \$300,000 grant approval for playground equipment at the Community Park on the east side of the park. Landscaping for the area surrounding the playground will also be landscaped in the amount of \$50,000, which will be taken from the grant. The Committee discussed the features of the Castle Park in Fruit Heights and the Ninja Park in St. Geroge. The Ninja Park has an obstacle course and a zipline that are popular attractions at this park. The Garret proposal was discussed, but the shade feature would put the cost at \$392,000.

13 Adam Alba reported the last time the Parks and Recreation Master Plan was updated was  
14 in 2012 when an intern completed it for his thesis. The City Council has asked the Committee to  
15 be more involved and give their ideas on how to upgrade the parks. Aaron Getz suggested a survey  
16 where citizens can give their responses on how the parks can be improved. The demographics of  
17 Centerville is changing to where there is now more of an aging population and fewer families with  
18 children.

20 Sean Hall discussed ways to improve Movies in The Park. He would like to see food trucks  
21 and perhaps a concert before the movie. He said Bountiful has Food Truck Friday with vendors at  
22 the water park every Friday evening, which has been very successful.
