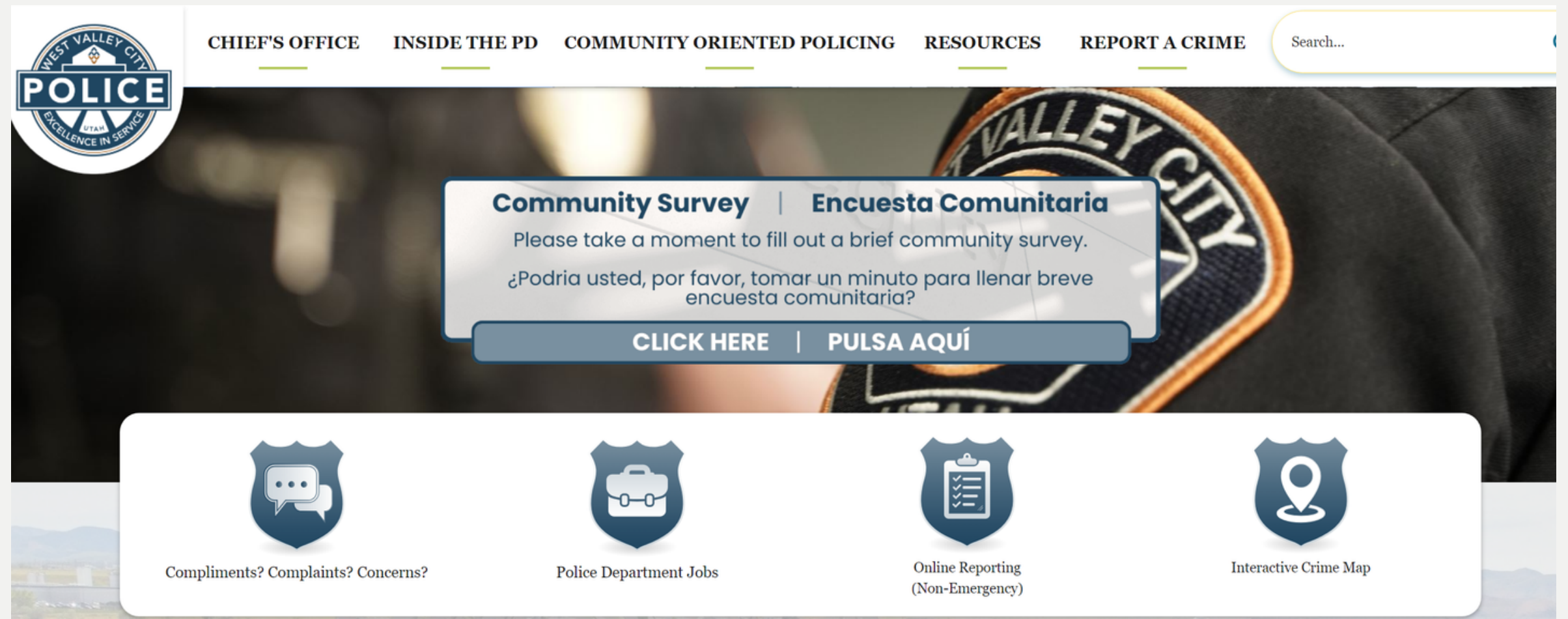
- Each package has different price points (I can request a discount if you purchase two or more):

- **Standard- \$3,806 (annual fee starting year 2 at \$813)**
  - Follows layout and color palette of the homepage ; can have their own site ID/logo, banner images on landing page and interior pages, graphic links, default content population.
- **Premium- \$5,453 (annual fee starting year 2 at \$938)**
  - Follows layout of the homepage with a custom color palette ; can have their own site ID/logo, banner images on landing page and interior pages, graphic links, default content population, unique section backgrounds color palette, widget placement.
- **Ultimate- \$7,403 (annual fee starting year 2 at \$1,313)**
  - Follows overall layout of the homepage with a custom color palette but widget areas can be customized ; can have their own site ID/logo, banner images on landing page and interior pages, graphic links, default content population, unique section backgrounds color palette, widget placement, widget type customizations.

## PUBLIC WORKS

The function of the Public Works Department is to direct culinary water, street and storm drain programs, and provide all related services in a safe and cost-efficient manner. The Department is responsible to maintain city owned infrastructure and facilities.

### DRAINAGE

The Drainage Utility Division maintains City owned stormwater facilities to prevent public and private property from flood damage. The division also oversees and administers the City's floodplain.

### FALL CLEANUP

The city provides a clean up service in the Fall and a Spring clean up service.

### FLOOD CONTROL

Centerville provides resources to citizens for flood control with city limits.

### GARBAGE & RECYCLING

Gather more information about the garbage and recycling services available in Centerville.

### GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM & MAPS
