MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

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18 Minutes of the December 10, 2024 meeting were reviewed. Sean Hall made a **motion** to
19 approve the minutes as written. Aaron Getz seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous
20 vote (5-0).

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NEW COMMITTEE MEMBER

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24 Andy Loosle was introduced as a new member of the Parks and Recreation Committee.
25 Adam Alba and Matt Layton are no longer on the Committee.

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UPDATE ON PLAYGROUND CONSTRUCTION

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29 The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the new Community Park playground was held on April
30 21st.

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PICKLEBALL FUNDRAISING

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34 Haley Turner, Community Services Manager, reported donations have been received for
35 seven paddleboard holders and six benches for the new pickleball courts at the Community Park.
36 Money is still being raised for other amenities. Bryce King, Administration Services Director, is
37 doing the logos for the benches and paddle holders. The city is hoping to raise more money at the
38 July 4th events, but the budget was increased for the courts, so businesses have not been solicited
39 for money.

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Haley Turner explained the city is going to do a Community Pickleball Introduction and
Open House at the new pickleball courts on July 3rd. The Parks and Recreation Committee will
pass out popsicles and talk about pickleball. Volunteers from all of the city committees will be
asked to help with this event on July 3rd from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

1 **MOVIES IN THE PARK VOLUNTEERING**

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15 **APPOINT NEW CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR**

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17 Tiffany Rees made a **motion** to nominate Sean Hall as chair of the Parks and Recreation
18 Committee. Jeff Lewis seconded the motion, which was passed by unanimous vote (5-0).

20 **PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN**

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22 Haley Turner, Community Services Manager, reported the Master Plan is the most
23 important item for the City Council at this time. The City Council is asking the Parks and
24 Recreation Committee to go through the Parks and Recreation portion of the Master Plan, and
25 update anything that needs to be changed. In 2018, a college intern was hired to go through the
26 Parks and Recreation section of the Master Plan. The intern made recommendations but they were
27 never adopted into the Master Plan.

29 Sean Hall said the Master Plan will be the main item of discussion at the next Parks and
30 Recreation Committee meeting. He asked Committee members to read the current Parks and
31 Recreation Master Plan before the next meeting. Tiffany Rees suggested a natural looking water
32 attraction at Smoot Park where children can walk through it.

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34 **RAP TAX**

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36 Haley Turner explained the RAP Tax will be voted on this fall for renewal. Committee
37 members are not allowed to ask people to vote for renewal of the RAP Tax, but they can inform
38 people what the RAP Tax is and what it is used for.

1 **MISCELLANEOUS**

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3 Aaron Getz reported the tennis net at the Island View Park has so many holes in it that it is
4 not useable. Aaron also reported that he has been at the Island View Park and Smoot Park when
5 kids on motorized dirt bikes have been riding through the playgrounds of these parks. They have
6 also been riding their bikes on the slides, which is extremely dangerous for the children that are
7 playing on the grounds. Haley Turner said the police should be called when citizens see this
8 activity happening.

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10 There is new turf at the batting cage at the Community Park on the north side. Grants from
11 Rocky Mountain Power paid for the new turf.
