29 The Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the Community Park playground was held on April 21st.

31 **PICKLEBALL FUNDRAISING**

33 Haley Turner, Community Services Manager, reported donations have been received for
34 seven paddleboard holders and six benches for the new Pickleball Courts at the Community Park.
35 Money is still being raised for other amenities. Bryce King, Administration Services Director, is
36 doing the logos for the benches and paddle holders. The city is hoping to raise more money at the
37 July 4th events, but the budget was increased for the courts, so businesses have not been solicited
38 for money.

40 Haley Turner explained the city is going to do a Community Pickleball Introduction and
41 Open House at the new pickleball courts on July 3rd. The Parks and Recreation Committee will
42 pass out popsicles and talk about pickleball. Volunteers from all of the city committees will be
43 asked to help with this event on July 3rd from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

24 **PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN**

26 Haley Turner, Community Services Manager, reported the Master Plan is the most
27 important item at this time. The City Council is asking the Parks and Recreation Committee to go
28 through the Parks and Recreation portion of the Master Plan, and update anything that needs to be
29 changed. In 2018, a college intern went through the Parks and Recreation section of the Master
30 Plan, the recommendations were never adopted into the city's Master Plan.

32 Sean Hall said the Master Plan will be the main item of discussion at the next Parks and
33 Recreation Committee meeting. He asked Committee members to read the current Parks and
34 Recreation Master Plan before the next meeting. Tiffany Rees suggested a natural looking water
35 attraction at Smoot Park where children can walk through it.
