I-15 WIDENING PROJECT UPDATE

Michael Romero from UDOT provided an update on the I-15 project. Mr. Romero reviewed UDOT's three-phase process—environmental (complete), procurement (underway), and construction (beginning in 2027). The \$2.9 billion project will span four years and involve extensive coordination. He outlined property impacts in Centerville, including three full acquisitions and several partial ones, as well as planned pedestrian bridges and drainage improvements.

City Manager Brant Hanson raised two items for council consideration: long-term maintenance of the UDOT-funded pedestrian bridges and aesthetic improvements at interchanges. The city would be responsible for ongoing upkeep, and upgraded landscaping would require a financial contribution above UDOT's \$100,000 allowance. Council members discussed maintenance challenges and emphasized aesthetics at Centerville's gateway. Mr. Romero noted decisions are needed by late 2025. The meeting concluded with discussion of traffic flow, safety during construction, and potential coordination with UTA. The Council expressed appreciation for UDOT's collaboration and planned to revisit key decisions as more details become available.

ADJOURNMENT

At 6:55 pm, Councilmember Summerhays **moved** to adjourn the work session which passed by a unanimous vote (5-0).
