
19 **REAUTHORIZATION OF RAP TAX AND ADOPTION OF MUNICIPAL CODE**
20 **AMENDMENTS – CMC 5.12 (RECREATIONAL, ARTS AND PARKS (RAP) TAX – 2025)**

22 The Mayor explained the special meeting was needed to implement the voter-approved
23 RAP tax by the end-of-March deadline. City Attorney Lisa Romney clarified that, in addition to
24 voter approval, state law requires the council to formally vote to impose the tax and adopt an
25 ordinance outlining how funds will be distributed. She noted the proposed ordinance follows the
26 city's standard 10-year framework and aligns with the original ballot language, and includes
27 ratification language to support the planned April 1, 2026 implementation after prior notice to the
28 Utah Tax Commission. The Mayor confirmed the tax passed with about 62% support and that no
29 public hearing was required.

31 Councilmember Hirst **moved** to authorize the imposition of the RAP Tax as approved by
32 the voters of Centerville City at the November 4, 2025 municipal election and approve Ordinance
33 No. 2026-07 enacting CMC 5.12 (Recreational, Arts And Parks (RAP) Tax - 2025) providing for
34 the imposition, collection, and distribution of the RAP Tax. Councilmember Hayman seconded the
35 motion which passed unanimously (5-0).
