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45 **CITY COUNCIL REPORT**

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47 Councilmember McEwan updated the Council on the Davis County Mosquito Abatement
48 District and the Centerville Trails Committee. He talked about House Bill 133 regarding the use

of eminent domain for trail systems. Brant Hanson, City Manager, reported that Staff are actively pursuing grant opportunities to fund hillside improvements to make planned bike trails possible.

MAYOR'S REPORT

- Mayor Wilkinson updated the Council regarding a Centerville property nominated for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places.
- The Mayor reported on a recent Mayor and City Manager meeting with Congressman Stewart.
- Legislative Night at the Davis Center for the Performing Arts is scheduled to take place on February 18th.
- Mayor Wilkinson informed the Council of the possibility of sending Council representatives to annual meetings of the National League of Cities and Towns.

APPOINTMENT

Mayor Wilkinson recommended the appointment of Del Ruesch to the Centerville Trails Committee. Councilmember Ince **moved** to support the appointment of Del Ruesch to the Trails Committee. Councilmember McEwan seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote (5-0).

CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

- Mr. Hanson reported that adding a donation line to monthly City utility bills would be possible and would require minimal Staff time.
- The City Manager reported that the City Recreation Director position is currently in transition.
- Staff is exploring the possibility of changing City website providers.
- Councilmember Ivie requested a City Council tour of the Island View Park Renovation before completion of the project. Councilmember Ince asked for a project update at the next Council meeting.
- The Council discussed the possibility of involving gubernatorial candidates in a community event, with input from Staff.
