Mayor Wilkinson read aloud a determination regarding electronic meetings without an anchor location due to COVID-19

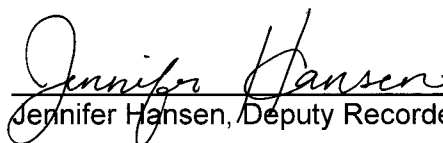
**2021 MUNICIPAL ELECTION – POLLING PLACE AND VOTING CENTERS**

State law required the City Recorder, as the election official, to designate the polling place for municipal elections and to obtain the approval of the City Council of such polling place in accordance with Utah Code 20a-5-403. The City Recorder designated the Centerville Library located at 45 South 400 West as the official polling place and voting center for the 2021 Municipal Elections. City Attorney Lisa Romney explained proposed Resolution No. 2021-22 was prepared for the purpose of approving the polling place and voting center.

Councilmember McEwan **moved** to approve Resolution No. 2021-22. Councilmember Ince seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote (3-0).
