DOG ORDINANCE RULES AT COMMUNITY PARK

Margot Thompson reported people are not walking at the Community Park like they used to because there are people who are not cleaning up after their dogs, and some dogs are not on a leash.

She said a woman from Animal Control has been at the park telling people they will be fined if they do not clean up after their dogs and obey the ordinances. Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, reported the park rules clarify that dogs must be on a leash, and dog owners must clean up after their dog. Animal Control is stepping up patrol of the parks, warning that people will be fined \$150 on the first offence and the fine increases for subsequent offences.

NEW SOUND SYSTEM AT FOUNDERS PARK

Loren Pankratz distributed price information on new sound system equipment for Founders Park. It is suggested two speakers be purchased to start with, and then add two other speakers at a later date. The speakers would be powered, which means separate amps would not be needed. The speakers are \$400 a piece and they will require new cables. The entire sound system would cost \$4,303. The Committee agreed they would like to purchase a mixer, two speakers, and two subwoofers for this summer. The Committee will wait to purchase the equipment until they receive their new budget from the City Council.

OTHER BUSINESS

The Committee discussed food preparation of outside vendors at the movies. Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, explained whoever handles food preparation must have a Food Handlers Permit from the County. Margot Thompson said she will contact the County to make certain of the rules for serving popcorn at the movies.

The slide at the Community Park has a crack at the base. It has been welded before, but it is cracked again and could be a safety hazard. Bruce Cox said he will inspect the problem and see it is fixed as soon as possible.
