Swank Motion Pictures Inc. The Committee will set movie titles to specific dates at their next meeting. The Committee will also decide who will host each night at their next meeting. The specific movie dates for 2014 are as follows: June 13th, June 20th, June 27th, July 11th, July 18th, August 1st, August 8th, and August 15th.

BUDGET REVIEW

Gary Goff reviewed the budget for the Movies in the Park events. The Committee has approximately \$5000. The City will purchase two (2) new speakers this year for the rear of the park (approximately \$1000). This will enhance the sound for patrons. The remainder of the budget will be used to purchase the movie rights for this year. Bruce Cox will order the movie titles from Swank Motion Pictures Inc. and contact Performance Audio about purchasing two new speakers.

MISCELLANEOUS

Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, will create a flyer to advertise this year's Movies in the Park dates and movie titles. The flyer will include the theme for each night and a list of the South Davis Recreation Centers movie series as well. Mr. Cox will bring a finished flyer to the next Parks and Recreation meeting for final approval.

The Committee discussed concessions. In the past several vendors have sold food before and during the movie showings. Bruce Cox explained all vendors are required to meet County Health regulations and obtain a food handlers permit. Mr. Cox said he approves all vendors and calls the County Health Department to verify the food handler permits.
