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20 **DISCUSS MOVIES IN THE PARK**

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22 The movie this week is the Lego Movie, and Loren Pankratz will be doing the movie.
23 Rebecca Wright reported she was in charge of the movie last week, and she wasn't sure how the
24 equipment worked. A group of citizens offered to help her, and the movie started at 9:30 p.m. After
25 the movie was over, the projector was unplugged before it had cooled down. City employee, Mike
26 Higgins, then arrived and he helped to put the equipment away. The Committee discussed having
27 a printed guide or colored tape on the cords to mark where they are to be plugged in.

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29 **REPORT ON AUGUST 21ST MOVIE/CENTENNIAL PARTY**

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31 Melissa Smith will be in charge of the August 21st Movie in the Park and the Centennial
32 Party prior to the movie. The movie will be the Lego Movie. Melissa is still trying to find a
33 company to do bounce toys for the party. She found a company in Provo, but they are requesting
34 a five hour minimum time for their toys at a cost of \$300. Melissa will continue to search for other
35 companies that could provide bouncy toys for two hours. Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation
36 Director, explained if there is a large gathering for two hours or more, a permit must be obtained
37 from the County to hold the event. The requirements from the County are very strict, so this is a
38 consideration on how long this event should be. The Committee estimates there will be 500 people
39 in attendance. Some businesses on Main Street have donated prizes for the raffle, but donations of
40 food and water bottles are also needed.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS

Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, displayed a brochure of swing sets for the Porter/Walton Park. The swing set can be purchased in different sections, with the entire set costing \$4,320. The swing set is part of the Capital Improvement Plan, and will be considered for purchase at a future date. The Committee discussed the possibility of a splash pad, as this is a popular feature with some citizens.

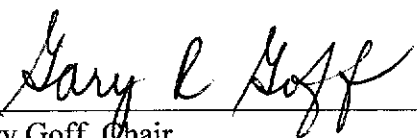

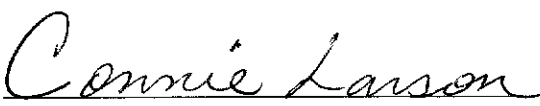
