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20 **REVIEW MOVIES IN THE PARK**

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22 The Committee discussed the End of Summer Bash on August 21st, and agreed it was a
23 great success. It is estimated there were 500 people in attendance. The Committee agreed the
24 electrical cords need to be color coded to make setting up and storage easier. The bounce houses
25 were scheduled from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., but the man who came to pick up the bounce houses
26 arrived at 8:45 p.m., and insisted on removing the houses instead of waiting until 9:00 p.m.

28 Overall, the Movies in the Park this past summer were a great success, and they were well
29 attended. Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, reported he found another movie company
30 that is less expensive than the movie company we have been using, but they do not have Disney
31 movies. The Committee will consider this company next year when planning the movies. The
32 placing of electrical cords in the ground instead of on top of the ground was discussed. There are
33 problems in the winter with freezing and water for underground electrical cords. Perhaps a single
34 conduit at the beginning of the season could be considered, and then it would be removed at the
35 end of the season. A training night for Committee members on the use of the equipment will be
36 held next year.

38 **DISCUSS PARKS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

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40 Chair Goff reported Mayor Cutler requested the Committee reconsider some of the items
41 on the Parks Capital Improvement Plan. There have been requests to update the Parrish Creek
42 Pond, and consideration of a dog park. The Committee discussed having a dog park, but expressed
43 concern about the liability to the City, and the resources needed to maintain and police a dog park.
44 Mr. Cox will research the costs of maintaining a dog park. The Committee also discussed having
45 a water park feature in Centerville instead of a splash pad, as splash pads are costly to maintain.

The replacement and maintenance of existing facilities at the parks need to be prioritized. Mike Smith will be asked to make a poster map of all the parks in Centerville with pictures featuring each park. This map will need to be done before the election in November when the RAP Tax will be voted on.

NEXT MEETING

The next Parks and Recreation Committee meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 22, 2015 if it is needed, and further discussion is required on the Capital Improvement Plan and the visual design of the poster.

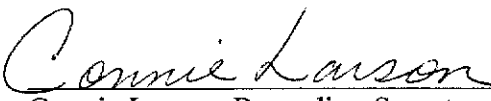
